Copilot Chat History Filtered by Experience

M365 CHANGE

Chat history in Microsoft 365 Copilot Chat will now default to showing only conversations from the current endpoint. Users can switch to an 'All chats' view if they want to see threads across all Copilot surfaces. GA scheduled for June 2026.

TAKEAWAY

- ✓ **If you use multiple Copilot endpoints, your chat sidebar will be cleaner — no more digging through unrelated threads from different surfaces.**

Teams AI Interpreter: Three Simultaneous Mode

M365 CHANGE

AI Interpreter's simultaneous mode is getting three changes arriving July 2026: audio and live captions now use the same selected language, admins can fully disable voice simulation, and dynamic voice assignments now distinguish each speaker more clearly.

TAKEAWAY

- ✓ **Multilingual Teams meetings via AI Interpreter will be less confusing — what you hear and what you read in captions will finally match.**

ASK

Mind Maps Now in Copilot Notebooks

M365 CHANGE

Copilot Notebooks in OneNote and the Microsoft 365 Copilot App now generate Mind Maps — interactive visual layouts of key topics, themes, and relationships drawn from notebook content. Users can explore nodes, read summaries, and ask follow-up questions. GA this month.

TAKEAWAY

✓ **For heavy OneNote users, Mind Maps offer a way to navigate dense notebooks without scrolling through pages of text.**

Teams Facilitator Detects Unanswered Questions

M365 CHANGE

Facilitator in Teams meetings now monitors for questions that nobody answers. When a participant raises something and the group moves on, Facilitator surfaces it and, with approval, retrieves an answer via web search. GA expected July 2026.

TAKEAWAY

- ✓ **Questions that get buried in busy meeting chat will now be flagged — useful for large all-hands sessions or training calls.**

ASK

Would you want an AI to publicly surface that a question went unanswered in your meetings?

Surveys Agent Integrated into Microsoft Forms

M365 CHANGE

Microsoft 365 Copilot Chat is now integrated into Forms, bringing a Surveys Agent that recommends improvements to forms and quizzes, helps draft invitation emails, and analyses results. Requires a Microsoft 365 Copilot licence. GA this month.

TAKEAWAY

✓ **Building and analysing surveys now has a built-in AI pass — useful if you run regular internal polls and hold a Copilot licence.**

ASK

What surveys are you building manually today that could benefit from an AI review?

Microsoft Agent 365 Now Generally Available

AI & PRODUCTIVITY

Microsoft's Agent 365 — a governance and security control plane for AI agents — is now GA at \$15 per user per month. It covers agents built on Copilot Studio, Foundry, and third-party platforms. New features include cross-cloud registry sync with AWS Bedrock and Google Cloud, and Windows 365 for Agents in US preview.

TAKEAWAY

- ✓ **Any organisation running AI agents across multiple platforms now has an official Microsoft tool to inventory, govern, and secure them from one place.**

NVIDIA and ServiceNow Partner on Governed

AI & PRODUCTIVITY

NVIDIA and ServiceNow announced at ServiceNow Knowledge 2026 an expanded partnership to deploy governed autonomous agents across enterprise environments — from individual employee desktops to large-scale AI factory infrastructure. The stated focus is reliability and governance, not raw model capability.

TAKEAWAY

 **Two major enterprise platforms are betting that managed, governed agents will outpace experimental ones — relevant if you are evaluating agent vendors this year.**

Automation Anywhere Launches Agentic

AI & PRODUCTIVITY

At Imagine 2026 on 19 May, Automation Anywhere announced new capabilities for its Agentic Process Automation platform, positioning it for end-to-end autonomous business process execution across systems and teams. The pitch is full process autonomy, not incremental task automation.

TAKEAWAY

 **The line between RPA and AI agents is collapsing. If your organisation uses Automation Anywhere, expect the roadmap to push toward fully autonomous process runs.**

Governance Is the New Battleground

EDITORIAL

This week's eight items point in one direction: the fight for enterprise AI has shifted from capability to control. Microsoft is tightening Copilot's grip on daily workflows — chat history, facilitator, mind maps, surveys agents — while Agent 365, the NVIDIA-ServiceNow partnership, and Automation Anywhere are all building governance layers for agent fleets. The technology is assumed to work. The question now is who manages it, who can see it, and who is liable when it does something unexpected.

SO WHAT?

If your organisation does not have an AI agent inventory in place, the platform vendors are about to build one for you — whether you asked for it or not. Get ahead of that conversation.
