Teams Facilitator answers open questions

M365 CHANGE

The Facilitator agent in Teams meetings now detects questions that go unanswered and offers to find a reply using web search. If someone asks a question and no one responds, Facilitator posts a prompt; a participant can accept and the agent shares what it finds. Roadmap ID 558341, GA expected July 2026.

TAKEAWAY

- ✓ **Meetings now have an agent listening for gaps, so be aware that questions you raise may be answered by software, not a colleague.**

ASK

When a meeting agent answers for the room, who checks that the answer is correct?

Project Manager agent comes to M365 Copilot

M365 CHANGE

A Project Manager agent is being added to Microsoft 365 Copilot to help plan, organise and track work. It starts with core task and plan management and will add more project features over time. Microsoft moved it from preview and now expects general availability in June 2026. Roadmap ID 516576.

TAKEAWAY

✓ **If you run plans in Planner or Project, expect an agent that can draft and update tasks for you from plain instructions.**

ASK

Which parts of project tracking are worth delegating, and which need a human owner?

Mind Maps arrive in Copilot Notebooks

M365 CHANGE

Copilot Notebooks gain Mind Maps: interactive visual artifacts that map the key topics, themes and relationships in a notebook. Users can open a node to read a summary or ask the notebook chat for more detail. Available across OneNote and the Microsoft 365 Copilot app. Roadmap ID 559029, GA May 2026.

TAKEAWAY

✓ **If you keep research or notes in a notebook, you can now see the structure as a map rather than a long page of text.**

ASK

Does a generated map of your notes match how you actually think about the topic?

Copilot Chat history filters by experience

M365 CHANGE

Microsoft 365 Copilot will scope your chat history to the Copilot endpoint you are currently using, with an option to switch to an All chats view. The aim is to stop chats from one surface cluttering another. Roadmap ID 559601, GA expected June 2026.

TAKEAWAY

- ✓ **Your Copilot history will be split by where you used it, so check the All chats view if a past conversation seems missing.**

ASK

Is history scoped by surface easier to navigate, or just one more place to look?

Teams Interpreter simultaneous mode gets

M365 CHANGE

Three changes are coming to AI Interpreter simultaneous mode in Teams. Interpreter audio and live captions now use the same language the user selects. Admins can fully disable voice simulation. Users get more platform voice options, with voices assigned dynamically to help tell speakers apart. Roadmap ID 562035, GA July 2026.

TAKEAWAY

- ✓ **Live interpretation in Teams becomes more consistent, and admins keep control over whether simulated voices are used at all.**

ASK

Where does a simulated interpreter voice help understanding, and where might it mislead?

Salesforce embeds an AI teammate in the interface

AI & PRODUCTIVITY

Salesforce introduced Agentforce Coworker, a beta feature that places an AI teammate inside searchable interfaces so it can retrieve CRM context and take actions in place. Salesforce also updated its Agentforce admin and certification materials. The update was published on 22 May 2026.

TAKEAWAY

✓ **Vendors are moving agents out of a separate chat window and into the screens people already work in.**

ASK

If an agent sits inside your CRM and can act, what actions should still require a click from you?

Anthropic ships sandboxes and MCP

AI & PRODUCTIVITY

Anthropic updated Claude Managed Agents with self-hosted sandboxes in public beta and a research preview called MCP tunnels. MCP tunnels let an agent call a company's internal MCP servers through an outbound-only encrypted gateway, so the agent reaches private tools without opening inbound access. Published 19 May 2026.

TAKEAWAY

✓ **The plumbing for agents is maturing toward letting them reach internal systems without widening the attack surface.**

ASK

Outbound-only access reduces one risk, but which internal tools should an agent reach at all?

Cyber agencies warn on agentic AI risk

AI & PRODUCTIVITY

Cybersecurity agencies in the United States, United Kingdom and Australia issued a joint warning about the security risks of agentic AI, pointing to a widened attack surface as agents gain credentials and permissions to act for people. The warning lands as agent products move from pilots into daily use.

TAKEAWAY

- ✓ **Government security bodies are flagging agent permissions and identity as the weak point, not the model itself.**

ASK

Do you know exactly what each agent in your stack can access, and who approved it?

Agents are crossing from assist to act

EDITORIAL

Read the eight items together and one line runs through them. Microsoft's Facilitator now answers questions in meetings, its Project Manager agent will draft and update plans, and Salesforce has put an agent inside the CRM that can take actions. At the same time, Anthropic is building tunnels so agents reach internal systems, and cyber agencies in three countries are warning that agent permissions and identity are now the soft spot. The pattern is not smarter chat. It is software that does things on your behalf, in the tools you already
