# Copilot Chat History Now Scoped by Endpoint

M365 CHANGE

Users will see chat history filtered to their current Copilot Chat endpoint by default, rather than all chats mixed together. A toggle lets them switch to the All chats view when needed. This change reaches general availability in June 2026.

## TAKEAWAY

- ✓ **If your team uses multiple Copilot entry points, this scoping reduces noise — past chats from other surfaces will no longer appear by default.**

## ASK

Do your users know which Copilot Chat endpoint they typically work from, or do they treat them as interchangeable?

## Teams Interpreter Gets Three Simultaneous Mode

M365 CHANGE

AI Interpreter in Teams Simultaneous mode gains three changes in July 2026: audio and live captions will use the same selected language; admins can fully disable voice simulation; and dynamic voice assignments will help distinguish speakers.

### TAKEAWAY

- ✓ **Organisations running multilingual meetings now have a full admin off-switch for AI voice simulation — useful where policy or cultural preference calls for it.**

### ASK

Has your organisation set a policy on AI voice simulation in interpreted meetings, or left it at the default?

## Teams Panel Devices Show Desk Availability at a Glance

M365 CHANGE

Teams panel-based desk dock devices such as the Yealink Linkhub will display desk availability and allow direct booking from the panel itself. Arriving in July 2026, the feature requires a Teams Shared Space licence per device.

### TAKEAWAY

- ✓ **For hot-desking offices, physical panel devices remove the need to book through an app — staff check the panel on arrival. The per-device licence cost needs to be in your planning.**

ASK

Does your organisation have a licence budget for Teams Shared Space devices, or are hot-desk panels still uncosted?

## Teams Facilitator Will Answer Unanswered

M365 CHANGE

The Facilitator AI agent in Teams will detect open questions raised during a meeting that nobody answers, then offer to find an answer via web search. Participants click Yes to receive the information. GA date is July 2026.

### TAKEAWAY

- ✓ **Meeting facilitators no longer need to track every unanswered question manually, though the quality of web-sourced answers will vary with question type.**

### ASK

Would your teams trust an AI-sourced answer to a live meeting question, or expect a human to verify it first?

# Mind Maps Now Available in Copilot Notebooks

M365 CHANGE

Mind Maps in Copilot Notebooks generate an interactive visual of key topics, themes, and relationships drawn from notebook content. Users can explore nodes, read summaries, and ask follow-up questions via Notebook chat. Available in OneNote and the Microsoft 365 Copilot App from May 2026.

## TAKEAWAY

- ✓ **For users working with large notebooks or research collections, the mind map view offers a faster way to see structure without building one manually.**

## ASK

How much of your team's knowledge currently lives in OneNote notebooks that have never been mapped or summarised?

# Microsoft Switched to Three Update Tracks Without

AI &amp; PRODUCTIVITY

Microsoft replaced its M365 rollout process with three tracks — Frontier (early access, unsupported), Standard (default GA), and Deferred (up to 30 days after standard) — launching on 16 April 2026 the same day as the announcement. It currently covers Copilot features only, with broader M365 expansion planned but unscheduled.

## TAKEAWAY

- ✓ **IT teams managing Copilot deployments should check their admin centre release settings now to confirm which track their organisation is on.**

## ASK

Does someone in your organisation have clear ownership of checking the M365 admin centre for change notifications?

# Microsoft Releases MCP Servers to Let AI Query Its

AI &amp; PRODUCTIVITY

Microsoft has released two Model Context Protocol servers: one connecting to public M365 and Azure roadmap data, and one connecting to an organisation's own Message Center and Service Health Dashboard. IT teams using Claude, GitHub Copilot, or other MCP-compatible assistants can now ask natural-language questions about upcoming changes.

## TAKEAWAY

- ✓ **Rather than reading Message Center manually, admins can query it through their AI assistant — a practical bridge between change management and AI tooling.**

## Gartner: 40% of Enterprise Apps to Include AI Agents

AI &amp; PRODUCTIVITY

Gartner estimates that 40% of enterprise applications will include task-specific AI agents by end of 2026, up from under 5% in 2025. Multi-agent systems are coordinating workflows across sales, support, finance, and operations. Many implementations are failing at organisations that treat agents as tools rather than managed workers.

### TAKEAWAY

- ✓ **The organisations seeing results are treating agents as workers — setting clear scope, monitoring outputs, and building governance before scaling.**

### ASK

If an AI agent made an error in a workflow your team runs today, would anyone catch it before it caused a downstream problem?

# Control Is the Theme This Edition

EDITORIAL

A single pattern runs through all eight items: Microsoft is adding more controls while simultaneously making deployment less predictable. The new update tracks give IT admins more levers, but those levers arrived without notice. Copilot Notebooks generate mind maps, Facilitator answers meeting questions, Teams agents book desks — but governance over when these features land is still being written. The Gartner agent data points the same direction: organisations struggling with AI agents are the ones who let capability outpace governance. The practical move this week is not to adopt more, but to audit what has already been deployed and confirm who owns it.
